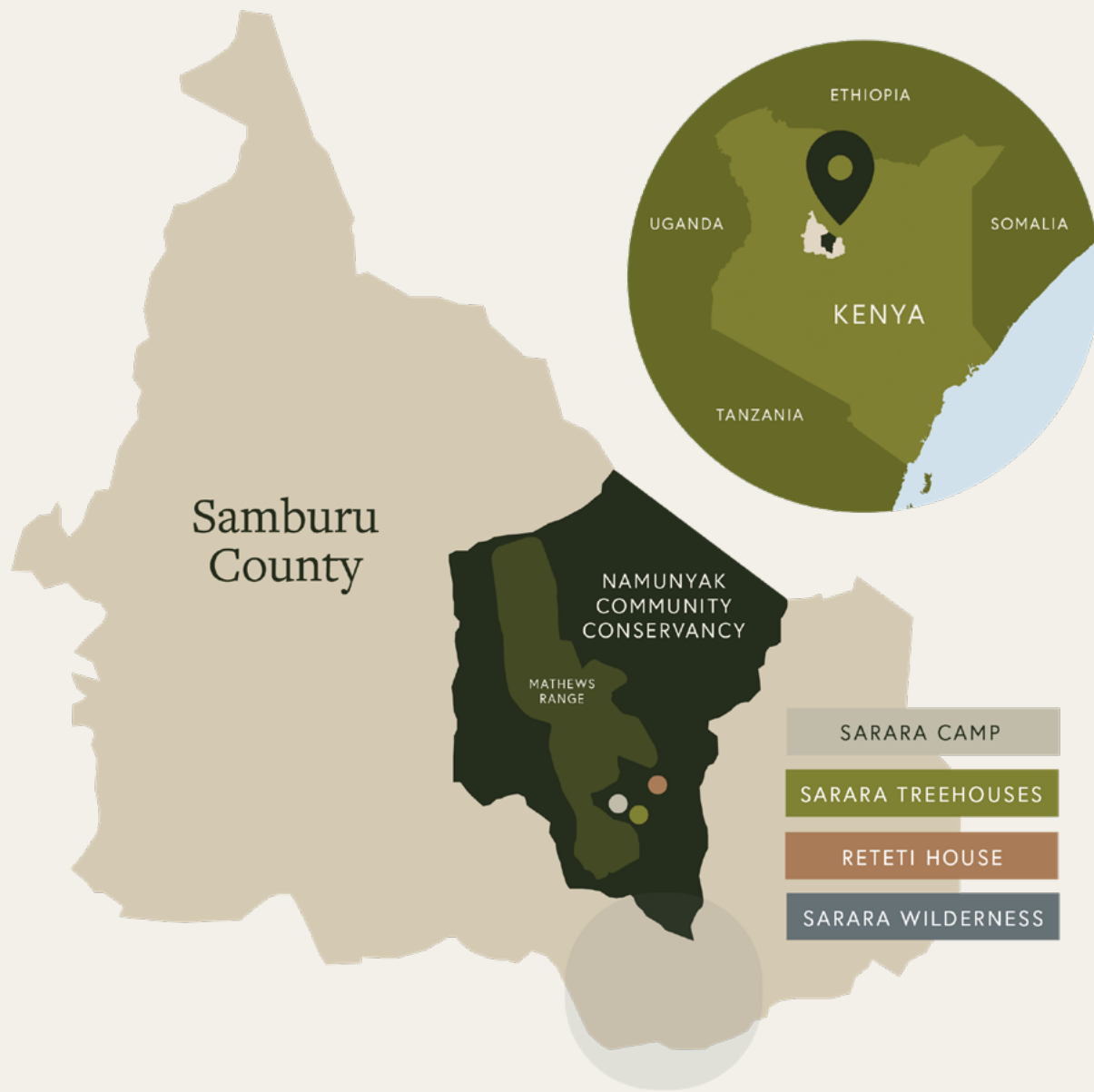




We are dedicated to preserving a landscape where people and wildlife flourish side by side for generations to come.

Our collection of ecolodges (Sarara Camp, Sarara Treehouses, and Reteti House) are all located in the 850,000-acre Namunyak Community Conservancy in Kenya's breathtaking northern frontier.

Each of these unique destinations is designed as a platform to build cultural and environmental sustainability – and proudly managed by the Samburu community.

Sarara Wilderness is an exclusive-use mobile camp set up in a remote location in the wider Samburu Ecosystem – and offers a front-row seat to an extraordinary concentration of iconic wildlife.



# Welcome to Sarara Treehouses

Nestled into a forest glade at the foot of Warges Peak, the Sarara Treehouses emerge from the ancient forest canopy.

Set in Northern Kenya within the 850,000 acre Namunyak Community Conservancy, this truly unique tree lodge encompasses the atmosphere and vibrancy that Sarara has become renowned for, whilst offering an incredible platform to experience the abundance of wildlife and rich Samburu culture of the Mathews Range.







The iconic setting of our rooms at Sarara Treehouses provides guests with the feeling of utmost sanctuary.

Eight beautiful tents are raised up into the forest canopy, allowing an array of wildlife including elephants and buffalo to roam the forest floor beneath you.

Each tent is en-suite, with solar heated outdoor showers looking into the forest.





## Discover the abundant wild and birdlife of Northern Kenya

Perched among hundreds of indigenous trees, Sarara Treeshouses is a bird and wildlife enthusiast's dream - not to mention the fauna and flora! Sarara Treehouses provides a front row seat to some of the most remarkable sightings.

Namunyak Conservancy is also home to the second largest population of elephants in Kenya, over 450 reticulated giraffe, the critically endangered Grévy's Zebra and a host of other species, including the fabled Generuk!

## Sarara Camp

Sarara Camp has six beautifully appointed en-suite tents with solar heated outdoor showers. The tents overlook the majestic Mathews Mountain Range, providing a fantastic platform by which to experience the 850,000-acre wildlife conservancy.

The camp waterhole is frequented by an array of wildlife including elephant, buffalo, kudu, impala, leopard, wild dog and reticulated giraffe.

A 10-minute walk from Reteti Elephant Sanctuary, Reteti House provides guests with a front-row seat to the extraordinary conservation work of Reteti.

#### RETETI ELEPHANT SANCTUARY

Reteti is a Samburu owned and run sanctuary supported by Sarara. Situated among Kenya's second largest elephant population, the Sanctuary takes in orphaned and abandoned elephant calves with an aim to release them back into the wild herds adjoining Reteti. This is the result of a widely recognised and expanding grassroots movement of community-driven conservation across Northern Kenya; a movement that is growing new economies, transforming lives and conserving natural resources.

# Need to know

## CHECK IN 11:00AM, CHECK OUT 10:00AM

## SEASON

Closed 1 November - 1 December

## CHILD POLICY

Children of all ages are welcome but more suitable for 5 years and over

## PHONE SIGNAL

Intermittent Safaricom signal

## WIFI

Intermittent Starlink WiFi, in main areas

## POWER

24-hour solar power. Charging points in room (plug type G) at floor level and in the main area. No adapters provided.

The voltage of the sockets are not strong enough for hairdryers but you will be able to charge your electronic devices.

## ALTITUDE

The camp is approx. 800 metres above sea level

## TEMPERATURE

The Mathews Range has a warm climate all year round. Nightly lows of 20-25 °C and daily highs of 30-35 °C

## GETTING THERE

Private charters into Namunyak airstrip.

Scheduled flight with Safarilink or Air Kenya to Kalama

Transfer: Kalama airstrip (Northern Samburu) to Sarara - US\$450 (max 4 passengers) Approx. 1.5 hrs drive.

Scheduled flight with Safarilink or Air Kenya to Lewa

Transfer: Lewa to Sarara - US\$550 (max 4 passengers) Approx. 3.5 hrs drive.

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Bookings are accepted on the condition that guests have their own comprehensive Travel Insurance to cover all eventualities.

Bookings are confirmed upon receipt of a 20% non-refundable deposit.

The balance is payable in full by 46 days prior to arrival.

To place a provisional booking: Please send an email to [info@sarara.co](mailto:info@sarara.co). Your booking will be held provisionally for 14 days. The expiry date of the booking will be noted on the reservation summary that you are sent. You are required to confirm the booking prior to the expiry date otherwise it will automatically expire. If you require more time to confirm your booking, the expiry date may be extended once (on request).

To confirm a booking: A booking shall only be confirmed upon receipt of the 20% NON-REFUNDABLE deposit. Proof of Comprehensive Travel Insurance is required.

Please ensure that the booking voucher contains the following information:

- Type of room you would like to book
- Date, time and method of guests arrival and departure
- Number of people in the group and rooming requirements
- Names of ALL guests in the group and ages
- Any special dietary requirements or other special requests

In the event of cancellation: Between 45-31 days 50% of the full payment will be forfeited. 50% will be refunded. Cancellations within 30 days of arrival forfeit the full payment. (If travel is prevented by Government or Pandemic related travel restrictions within 45 days of arrival, either to Kenya, or from guest's home

country, postponement of travel to within 1 year is possible, subject to seasonal rates applying on new dates.)

Guests are required to complete a registration card on check-in.

Room check out time is 10:00AM on the day of departure and check in is 11:00AM on day of arrival.

We reserve the right to review published rates in the event of currency exchange rate fluctuation, increases in costs or taxes, that are beyond our control.
