

Each of these unique destinations is designed as a platform to build cultural and environmental sustainability – and proudly managed by the Samburu community.




Welcome to Sarara Wilderness

Located in one of Africa's last true wilderness areas, Sarara Wilderness allows guests to embark on their own tailormade adventure – and experience the romance and nostalgia of an exclusive tented camp set up in the heart of the bush.

The camp offers intimate access to prime wildlife sightings and ancient elephant corridors, guided by the deep knowledge of your Samburu hosts, who understand the landscape, seasons, and the region's incredible wildlife.











Sarara Wilderness offers a complete immersion in nature – while treating guests to all the comforts of an immaculately appointed modern tented camp.

As the perfect blend between adventure and comfort, the camp was carefully planned with travellers yearning for extraordinary natural encounters in mind. Key features include:

- up to 6 en-suite tents with solar-heated bucket showers
- a comprehensive wellness and media tent – offering everything from a specially curated library to mod-cons like charging stations
- a relaxing dining and lounge tent
- a mobile swimming pool and refreshing cold plunge machines



Sarara Wilderness can be set up to match guests' group size and preferences and is highly personalised.

SUNDOWNERS


No sunset is ever the same during a stay at Sarara Wilderness – and each wild and remotely set sundowner spot provides a unique kind of magic.



Sarara Camp

Sarara Camp has six beautifully appointed en-suite tents with solar heated outdoor showers. The tents overlook the majestic Mathews Mountain Range, providing a fantastic platform by which to experience the 850,000-acre wildlife conservancy.

The camp waterhole is frequented by an array of wildlife including elephant, buffalo, kudu, impala, leopard, wild dog and reticulated giraffe.



Sarara Treehouses

Nestled into a forest glade at the foot of Warges Peak, the Sarara Treehouses emerge from the ancient forest canopy.

Eight beautiful tents are raised up into the forest, allowing an array of wildlife including elephants and buffalo to roam the forest floor beneath you.

Each tent is en-suite, with solar heated outdoor showers looking into the forest.



Reteti House

Reteti House is an exclusive and uniquely crafted ecolodge that blends naturally into the dramatic landscape of Namunyak Conservancy.

Four standalone rooms, each with a gorgeous outdoor shower and private deck, offers uninterrupted views over the conservancy.

A 10-minute walk from Reteti Elephant Sanctuary, Reteti House provides guests with a front-row seat to the extraordinary conservation work of Reteti.

Need to know

EXCLUSIVE USE

Sarara Wilderness is ideal for couples and larger groups/families of 4 or more, and the camp can accommodate 6 en-suite guest tents – with 2 guests per tent.

CHECK IN 11AM, CHECK OUT 10AM

SEASON Closed 1 November - 1 December

CHILD POLICY

Children of all ages are welcome, but the camp is more suitable for those 5 years and older.

PHONE SIGNAL

Intermittent Safaricom signal

WIFI Intermittent Starlink WiFi, in main areas

POWER

Electricity is provided through solar, and all tents have plug points. Please note that the voltage of the sockets is not strong enough for hairdryers, but sufficient for charging electronic devices.

GETTING THERE

Sarara Wilderness is within reach of both Kalama and Buffalo Springs airstrips. Guests can opt for scheduled flights with Safarilink or Air Kenya – or make use of private charters.

ALTITUDE The camp is approx. 800 metres above sea level

TEMPERATURE

The region has a warm climate all year round. Nightly lows of 20-25 $^\circ C$ and daily highs of 30-35 $^\circ C.$

SARARA PORTFOLIO

For guests who will also be staying at Sarara's other eco lodges, the travelling time to Sarara Camp, Reteti House, and Sarara Treehouses is 2.5 hours.

Bookings are accepted on the condition that guests have their own comprehensive Travel Insurance to cover all eventualities.

Bookings are confirmed upon receipt of a 20% non-refundable deposit.

The balance is payable in full by 46 days prior to arrival.

To place a provisional booking: Please send an email to info@ sarara.co. Your booking will be held provisionally for 14 days. The expiry date of the booking will be noted on the reservation summary that you are sent. You are required to confirm the booking prior to the expiry date otherwise it will automatically expire. If you require more time to confirm your booking, the expiry date may be extended once (on request).

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

To confirm a booking: A booking shall only be confirmed upon receipt of the 20% NON-REFUNDABLE deposit. Proof of Comprehensive Travel Insurance is required.

Please ensure that the booking voucher contains the following information:

- Type of room you would like to book
- Date, time and method of guests arrival and departure
- Number of people in the group and rooming requirements
- Names of ALL guests in the group and ages
- Any special dietary requirements or other special requests

In the event of cancellation: Between 45-31 days 50% of the full payment will be forfeited. 50% will be refunded. Cancellations within 30 days of arrival forfeit the full payment. (If travel is prevented by Government or pandemic related travel restrictions

within 45 days of arrival, either to Kenya, or from guest's home country, postponement of travel to within 1 year is possible, subject to seasonal rates applying on new dates.)

Guests are required to complete a registration card on check-in.

Room check out time is 10:00AM on the day of departure and check in is 11:00AM on day of arrival.

We reserve the right to review published rates in the event of currency exchange rate fluctuation, increases in costs or taxes, that are beyond our control.
