Lekurruki Community Conservancy is a community-driven conservation area located in the northern reaches of Kenya, where the Yiaku people have come together to protect and sustainably manage their land, wildlife, and cultural heritage. Spanning rugged landscapes, from rolling hills to acacia-dotted plains, Lekurruki is home to diverse flora and fauna, including elephants, giraffes, and endangered Grevy's zebras. The conservancy not only offers a sanctuary for wildlife but also empowers local communities through eco-tourism, education, and sustainable development, creating a harmonious balance between people, wildlife, and nature.

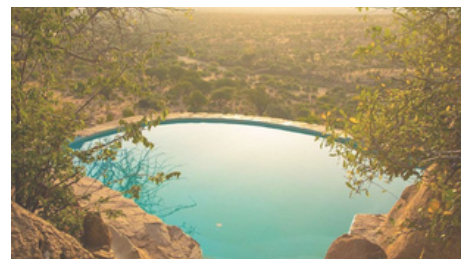
